**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** of a vacancy on the Board of Directors for Division 2 of the San Luis Rey Municipal Water District, as of December 6, 2024. The term of such vacated office extends to December 6, 2024. The next election to fill the office is scheduled for the general election in November of 2028.

The letter of interest should be submitted to the above address by interested persons no later **than close of business fifteen (15) days after the posting date above**. The Board will consider the qualifications of the applicants and will appoint the Division 2 Director at its future Board meeting.

The District was formed on October 17, 1958 pursuant to the Municipal Water District Act of 1911 (Cal. Water Code §§ 71000, *et seq.*). San Luis Rey's purposes and activities include, but are not limited to, such things as monitoring and acting upon issues which impact water, land and environment, and other activities which can potentially affect the quality or quantity of the water available to the water users in the District; monitoring developments under the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act and groundwater sustainability agency activities; and monitoring the proceedings of the federal and State government environmental agencies and environmental advocacy groups that could restrict water production, water use, or construction and operation of water management facilities.

The five-member Board of Directors is elected and receives no salary. The Board meets on the third Wednesday of the month, at 4:00 p.m. at the Pankey Ranch Office, which is at 5328 Highway 76, Fallbrook, California 92028.

To be eligible for Board membership, a candidate must be eighteen years of age, a registered voter in the County of San Diego and a legal resident of Division 2 of the District.

This notice is being posted in the District pursuant to Section 1780 of the Government Code, at least fifteen days before the appointment is made.
